General Information

School Day: 8:20—3:20

Doors to the building will ordinarily be open at 8:05 AM. Depending on the weather, doors may open slightly earlier. Students may not enter the building earlier unless they have made prior arrangements and have a pass.

Students staying after school for help or extracurricular activities must be supervised by a staff member.

Bus Drop off:

Students who ride the bus will be dropped off at the front of the building. After school, students will wait either inside or outside, depending on weather, until their bus arrives.

Student Drop Off/Pick Up:

9th Avenue will be blocked off before and after school to allow for busses to get through. Therefore, parents who are dropping off or picking up students should park along Oak Street.
